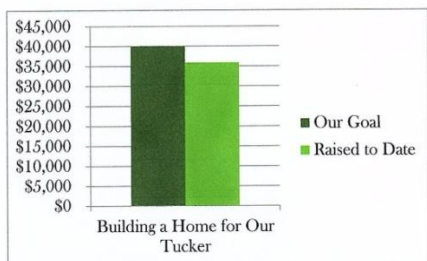

HERE COMES THE GROOMER

Our Tucker is equipped with a Collett Electronics' Groomer Warning Beacon. The device transmits a signal on the International Channel of Collett Communicator's Doofone and DMS series 900MHz communicators so that you are alerted when a groomer is working within a 1/2 mile radius of your location. If you're looking for a headset for your helmet, you might want to check out Collett's website. Their headsets come with 3 channel frequencies. Two of the channels allow access to standard frequencies and the third can be programmed from a list of options. For ease in group riding, the company has assigned a frequency channel to most of the snowmobile clubs in New England. The Snow Fleas' frequency is 51234.
