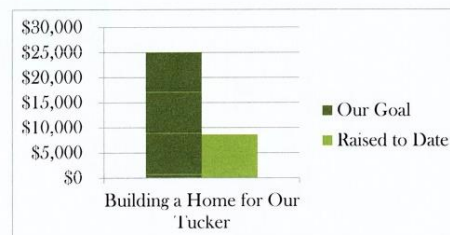
## PIG ROAST #2 - A HUGE SUCCESS!
