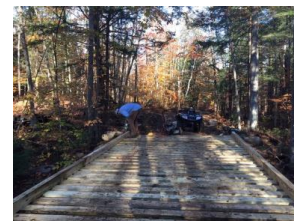
WE NEED YOUR INPUT
