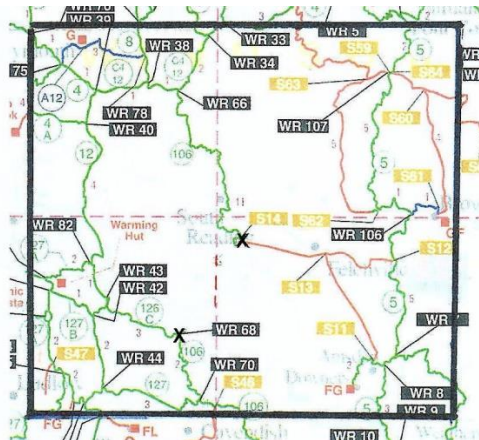
IMPORTANT TRAIL INFORMATION

ROUTE CHANGE CORRIDOR 12N AT WR 43

When leaving the Cavendish Cook Shack at WR 43, Corridor 12N goes right onto Twenty Mile Stream Rd.; then immediately into the woods on the right side of the road; exits the woods; crosses the road through an opening in the stone wall; and into a field on the left side of the road before continuing north through the woods.

Club members have worked very hard for a year to get this portion of the trail off of Chapman Road. **Permission has been granted for one year only and will only be extended if there are no issues. Please follow the arrows and signs and stay on the groomed trail.**
