## 2021 TMA SALES

2021 TMAs will be available for sale **online only** beginning Oct. 1st.

There is a link on the VAST website which will connect you to videos which will walk you through the online process, including how to upload a copy of your registration for verification, how you can join more than one club, and how you can donate to your club or other initiatives.

All VAST members from 2020 will be sent a Membership Card starting this week. The card will have your name, address, and a unique Member ID number to help you log into the system. Using this ID will prefill all your information, including name, address, phone number, email address, and all your snowmobile information. Your Membership number will be the same each year.

If you **did not** purchase a 2020 TMA, your information may not be in the VAST database. You will need to enter your info when you purchase a 2021 TMA.

If you do not use your Membership Card to purchase your TMA, you will just need to input all your information into the system.

## VERMONT REGISTRATION AGENT CHANGES

New Vermont registrations and registration renewals, transfers, and missing registrations must be done directly with the Vermont Department of Motor Vehicles either in person or online.

The only exceptions are:

If you are buying a snowmobile in Vermont from a dealer who is a Vermont Registration Agent directly through DMV **or** if you are registering through one of the few out of state dealers contracted with VAST to act as a Registration Agent.

Vermont sends all renewal information to snowmobile owners in August. Plan ahead if you register your snowmobile in Vermont so you are not caught with a sled you can't ride when the snow flies.

Vermont registration renewals can be done online at <https://dmv.vermont.gov/registrations> or in person. Vermont also accepts other state's registrations when buying your TMA. For more information on riding in Vermont, visit [www.vtvast.org](http://www.vtvast.org).

Out of state dealers with the ability to renew Vermont snowmobile registrations are Enfield Motor

Sports, Enfield, CT; Hunter's, Wallingford, CT; and Land N' Sea Powersports, Waterbury, CT.
